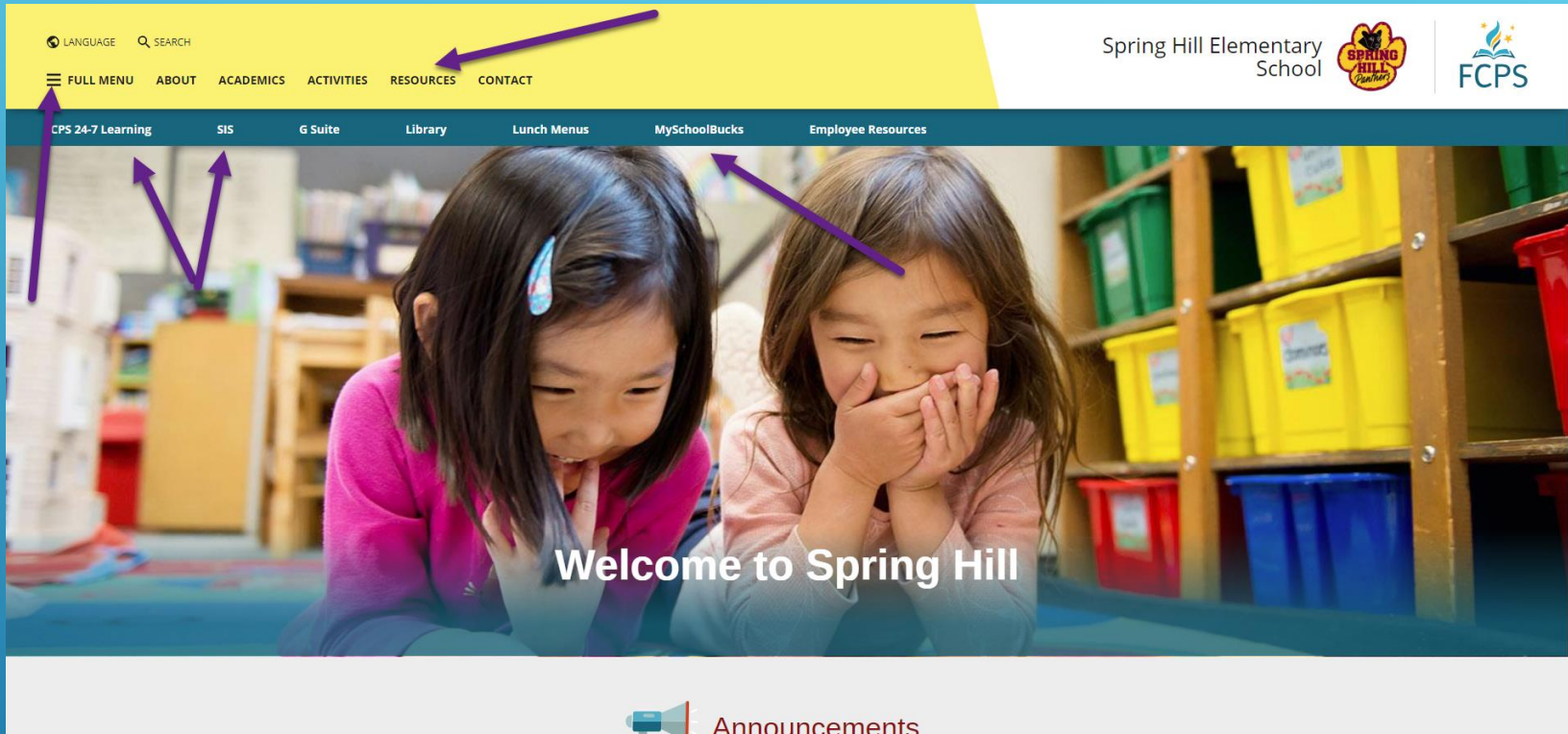



SIS enables a parent to access information about his/her child's attendance, class performance, course materials and more.

SIS Student Account - StudentVUE
StudentVue offers access to class schedules, grades, report cards, and more

You'll need to register and activate your account before using SIS/Blackboard

- After clicking on "SIS" from any FCPS website, scroll down to "SIS Parent Account – Registration"
- You'll need the activation code mailed to you at the start of the year/when you registered
 - Lost/Never Received Code? – Contact Bill Mosher or Mandy Belcher for a new code
- Think you might already have an account? Go to the login page and click on "forgot password"
 - Your SIS/Blackboard username is the e-mail address you used to register; password is chosen by the user during the registration process – Same credentials for SIS and Blackboard

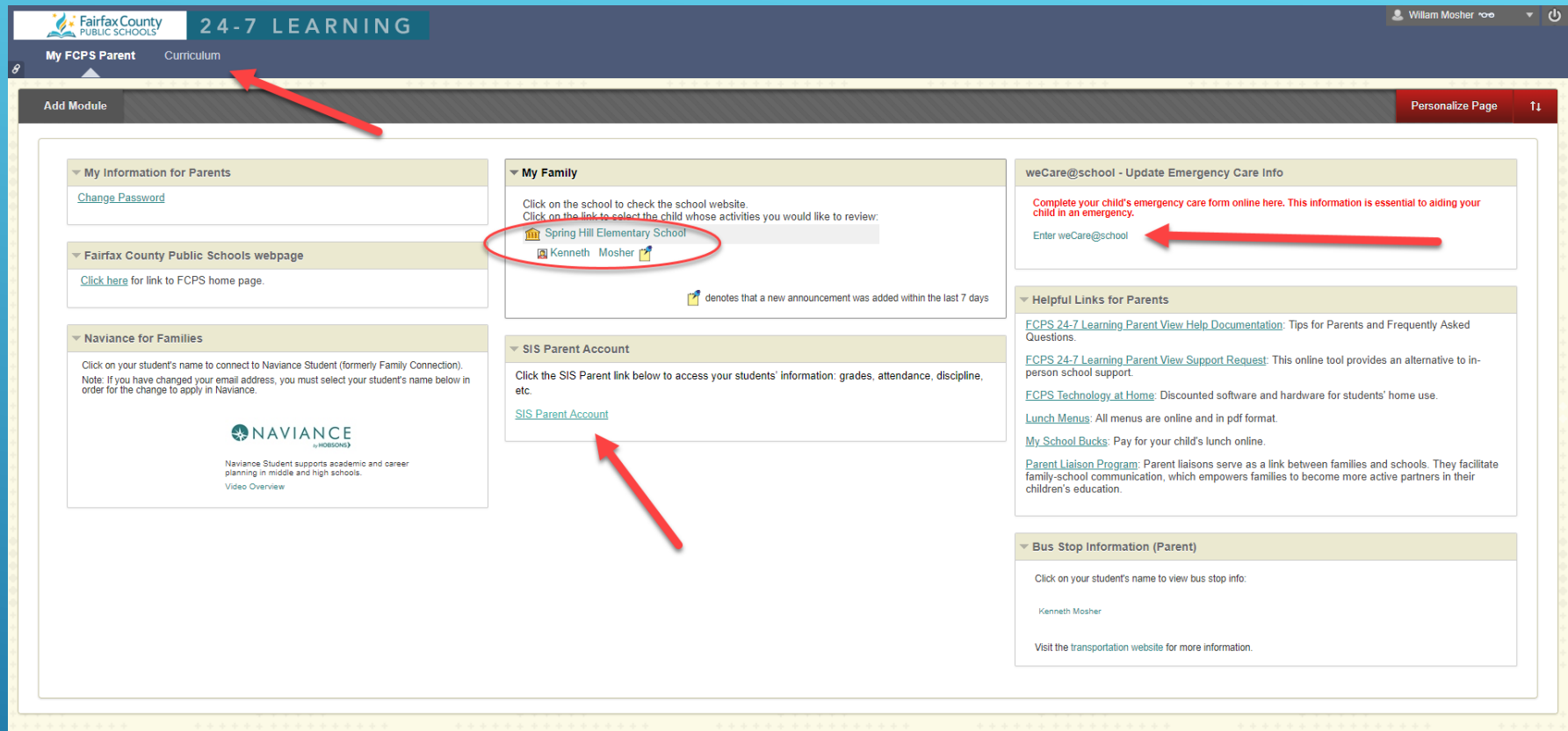


Blackboard (FCPS Learning 24-7) – Parent View

- Default starting view is class announcements
- Additional content is available using the buttons on the left-hand side
- Parents have “observer” access and may not be able to download/view all links/files
 - If you need to access something specific, you may want to log in as your child
