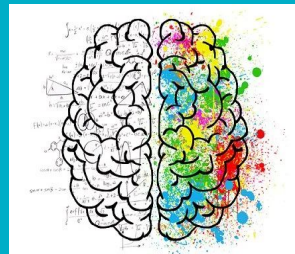

What is Schoology?

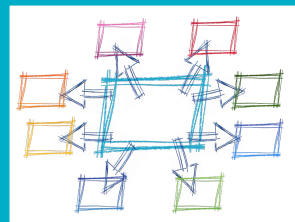

How was Schoology selected?

A team of teachers, students, principals, APs, central office staff selected Schoology.

It was piloted in 17 schools during the 2019-2020 school year.

For Parents:

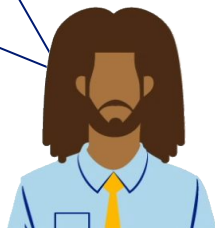

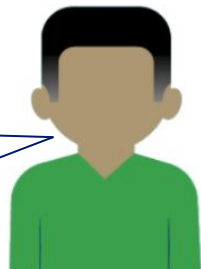


Ability to see assignments and my child's ability to communicate with teachers

It organizes all my work into folders so if I am looking for something, I can easily find it.

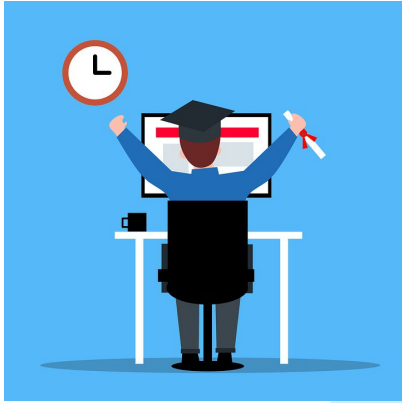


Schoology helps me keep all my classes and clubs organized and allows me to organize them the way I would like, which is really helpful.





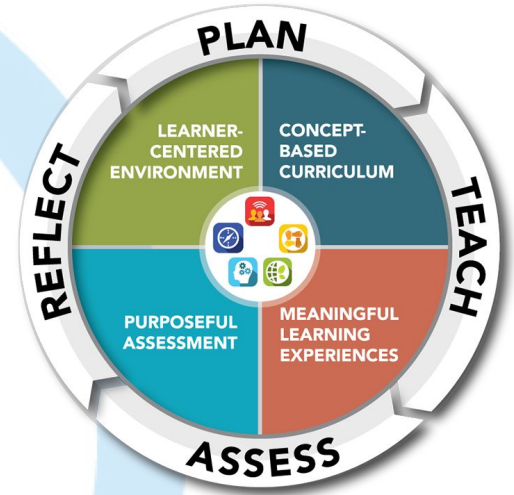

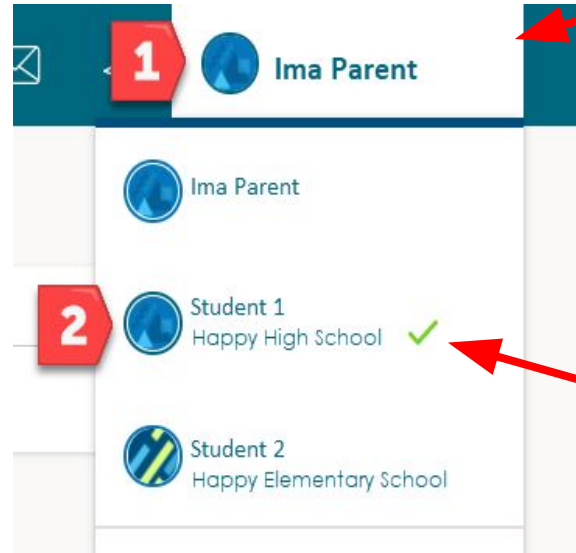
Parents have a personal Schoology calendar. The calendar can be accessed by clicking on the Calendar icon on the banner

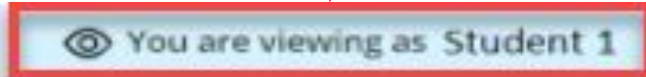
Switching Accounts (Parent → Student Account)
