What is Schoology?




A Learning Management System

(LMS) that enhances communication, collaboration, and personalized learning for students, teachers, and families



Learning: it is used for student learning.



Management: it helps organize courses and classes



System: means "software."





How was Schoology selected?

A team of teachers, students, principals, APs, central office staff selected Schoology.

It was piloted in 17 schools during the 2019-2020 school year.



No more having to go from one platform to the other to look for the class links, then for assignments, then grades, etc.



Teachers can provide real-time feedback to encourage deeper thinking




Schoology works with Google Drive, so students can work together during and after class time

When you login to Schoology, you will see your **Recent Activity** page which displays updates from the school, courses, and groups in which you/your child participate.

You will receive an email that alerts you to new updates.

PARENT Calendars


Parents have a personal Schoology calendar. The calendar can be accessed by clicking on the Calendar icon on the banner




Your personal calendar displays personal events you've created for your account, as well as events for the school, courses, and groups in which you're enrolled. This may include:

Student Activity Page




When you switch to your child's view, you will see their **Student Activity** page which shows updates from the school, courses, and groups in which your child participates.

You will **NOT** receive an email that alerts you to new student activity updates.


Student Activity Page

- Recent graded assignments




STUDENT Calendars

Viewing Student Gradebooks


Assignments included in the ParentVue SIS Gradebook may include assignments, projects, and assessments from a variety of sources used in Schoology.



SIS Vs. Schoology Gradebooks

PLEASE NOTE: SIS and Schoology grade books might not match. The SIS gradebook is the gradebook of record.


The Schoology gradebook should be used as a tool to review grades given for individual assignments and can help explain final grades to parents. Only SIS will show final grades.



Parent Notifications




Parents are in control of their settings! If you wish to change your notification alerts, use the following steps:

Parent Notifications




Customize your notifications as a parent!

From your child's account, you can also access the same settings to receive <u>The Parent Email</u> Digest.

This email will contain:

- Upcoming assignments/class activities
- Up to 10 recent activity items, like
 - o your child's posts and updates in courses,
 - o assignments,
 - tests/quizzes,
 - o discussions, etc.
- Overdue items


